The successful candidate shall engage in a robust creative and professional development program that includes scholarship accomplishments, and actively participate as a cooperative part of the faculty at the School, College, University, and community levels. The candidate shall demonstrate a strong commitment to take a leadership role in integrating teaching technologies including the development of web-based coursework. Importance given to applicants who are capable of cross-disciplinary teaching and /or research collaborations within the school and University.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Terminal Masters degree in Architecture required. Consideration will be given to those with recognized professional and academic work, teaching experience, registered architects/interior designers, LEED professional accreditation and/or a doctoral degree. AA/EOE/WMA.
