# ACADEMIC VACANCY

**POSITION:** Coordinator of Music Theory Division/Assistant Professor of Music Theory. Applied or other teaching as expertise and departmental needs warrant.

**RANK/SALARY:** Tenure Track. Assistant Professor. Salary competitive, commensurate with qualifications and experience.

**STARTING DATE:** August 20, 2008

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Teach undergraduate and graduate theory classes including Analysis of Musical Form and Analysis of 20<sup>th</sup> Century Music. Teach in applied or other areas of expertise as needs of the School of Music warrant. Assist with student advising and participate in academic affairs of the department. May be required to teach in general areas of music and participate in committee work as warranted by departmental need, or as assigned by the Director.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Doctorate in music theory or composition required. Demonstration of successful college level teaching skills. The candidate should possess outstanding organizational and communication skills and have interest in collaborative efforts with other faculty within the College of the Arts. There must be a demonstrated commitment to scholarship and creative activity. International faculty members are responsible for obtaining their own work visas.

**THE DEPARTMENT:** The National Association of Schools of Music (NASM) has accredited The School of Music (SOM), located in the College of the Arts, since 1952. Degrees include the Bachelor of Music, Bachelor of Music Education, and the Master of Music. There are 21 full-time faculty serving approximately 185 music majors. Recognized as a center for musical performance, composition, research, and music technology, the SOM is housed in 56,000 square foot Angelle Hall and hosts approximately 100 concerts, recitals, competitions, or other performances each year. There are numerous opportunities for performance with ensembles sponsored by the School of Music, as well as with other community organizations. **THE UNIVERSITY AND COMMUNITY:** The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is the largest of eight state institutions governed by the University of Louisiana System. UL Lafayette offers 80 active baccalaureate, 29 master's, 1 post master's, and 9 doctoral degree programs. The university is recognized as a supportive body for the arts in the community. Lafayette is the heart of Louisiana's Acadian-Creole region. The city of over 130,000 is one of Louisiana's fastest-growing and is the hub of numerous music and cultural festivals.
