ACADEMIC VACANCY

Director of the Instructional Center and Instructor of Children's Literature

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The applicant will be responsible for overseeing, maintaining, and operating the Instructional Materials Center in the Department of Curriculum and Instruction and for teaching undergraduate courses in children's literature. In addition, duties include advising students in the College of Education; supervising student teachers; serving on departmental, college, and/or university committees; and engaging in scholarly activities. The successful applicant will be expected to participate fully in other activities of the department, college, and university.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The applicant must have an earned Masters degree in Library Science or in Education with certification or specialization in Library Science. Candidates must have at least three years of experience in K-12 schools. Experience teaching at the college level is desirable. Preference will be given to applicants who have had experience supervising school libraries, material, and/or media centers.

ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is one of eight publicly supported universities in the University of Louisiana System. Degree granting units at UL Lafayette include the Colleges of Arts; Sciences; B.I. Moody III Business Administration; Education; Engineering; General Studies; Liberal Arts; and Nursing and Allied Health Professions. The University has an enrollment of approximately 16,300 with a faculty of 550. The University offers undergraduate, master's, and doctoral degrees.

The College of Education consists of three academic departments in the disciplines of Curriculum and Instruction; Educational Foundations and Leadership; and Kinesiology. The college has an enrollment of approximately 2500 students with a faculty of 60.

The Department of Curriculum and Instruction has 31 faculty members and offers degree programs in Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, Middle School Education, Secondary Education, and Special Education at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
