ACADEMIC VACANCY

Assistant Professor of Early Childhood Education (Tenure Track)

RESPONSIBILITIES:

The applicant will be responsible for teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in early childhood education and teaching methodologies. In addition to teaching, duties include advising students in the College of Education; supervising student teachers; serving on departmental, college, and/or university committees; and engaging in scholarly activities. The successful applicant will be expected to participate fully in other activities of the department, college, and university.

QUALIFICATIONS:

The applicant must have earned a terminal degree in Early Childhood Education or in Education with graduate level emphasis in early childhood education. Candidates must have at least three years of successful teaching experience in preschool and/or early childhood grades. Preference will be given to candidates who also have a background in literacy or reading. Experience teaching at the college level is desirable. In addition, the applicant should have received or show potential for recognition for scholarly publications, grants, and participation in professional organizations and conferences. Candidates who are ABD will be considered, but degree must be completed prior to starting date.

ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is one of eight publicly supported universities in the University of Louisiana System. Degree granting units at UL Lafayette include the Colleges of Arts; Sciences; B.I. Moody III Business Administration; Education; Engineering; General Studies; Liberal Arts; and Nursing and Allied Health Professions. The University has an enrollment of approximately 16,300 with a faculty of 550. The University offers undergraduate, master's, and doctoral degrees.

The College of Education consists of three academic departments in the disciplines of Curriculum and Instruction; Educational Foundations and Leadership; and Kinesiology. The college has an enrollment of approximately 2500 students with a faculty of 60.

The Department of Curriculum and Instruction has 31 faculty members and offers degree programs in Early Childhood Education, Elementary Education, Middle School Education, Secondary Education, and Special Education at the undergraduate and graduate levels.
