Instructor of Instructional Technology in the Department of Curriculum and Instruction

**RESPONSIBILITIES:**

The applicant will be responsible for teaching introductory technology and beginning technology integration classes for undergraduates in both the on-campus and off-campus programs. In addition, duties include advising students in the College of Education; supervising student teachers; serving on departmental, college, and/or university committees; and engaging in scholarly activities. The successful applicant will be expected to participate fully in other activities of the department, college, and university.

**QUALIFICATIONS:**

The applicant must have earned a Master's Degree in Curriculum and Instruction or related area of Education with specialization in instructional technology. Candidates must have at least three years of experience teaching at the PK-12 as well as at the college level. Preference will be given to applicants with experience in integrating technology into classroom instruction, and using Moodle and PASS-PORT.

**ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:**

The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is one of eight publicly supported universities in the University of Louisiana System. Degree granting units at UL Lafayette include the Colleges of Arts; Sciences; B.I. Moody III Business Administration; Education; Engineering; General Studies; Liberal Arts; and Nursing and Allied Health Professions. The University has an enrollment of approximately 16,300 with a faculty of 550. The University offers undergraduate, master's, and doctoral degrees.
