- POSITION:** Instructor of Education in the Department of Curriculum and Instruction
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The applicant will be responsible for teaching early childhood, elementary, and/or middle school education methods courses. In addition to teaching, there will be duties in the areas of advising students in the College of Education, supervising student teachers, overseeing summer GT programs, and serving on departmental, college, and/or university committees. He/She will be expected to participate fully in other activities of the department, college, and university.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** The applicant must have earned a Master's Degree in Curriculum and Instruction or related area of Education. Candidates must have experience teaching at the early childhood, elementary, and/or middle school level as well as at the college level. Preference will be given to applicants with expertise in gifted education and/or reading instruction or early childhood education.
- ADMINISTRATIVE UNIT:** The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is one of eight publicly supported universities in the University of Louisiana System. Degree granting units at UL Lafayette include the Colleges of Arts; Sciences; B.I. Moody III Business Administration; Education; Engineering; General Studies; Liberal Arts; and Nursing and Allied Health Professions. The University has an enrollment of approximately 16,300 with a faculty of 550. The University offers undergraduate, master's, and doctoral degrees.
