- POSITION:** Assistant Professor (tenure-track; 9 month)
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The candidate will teach undergraduate courses in child and family studies; recruit and advise students; participate in professional organizations; perform research and disseminate information through publication and presentation; participate in program assessment.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidate must have earned a Ph.D. in child and family studies or closely related field. At least one graduate degree must be in Child and Family Studies. Candidate must demonstrate evidence of leadership, research ability, teaching in higher education setting, good interpersonal skills, involvement in professional activities.
- ADMINISTRATIVE:** The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is one of 8 publicly supported universities in the University of Louisiana system. It consists of 9 degree-granting units - The Colleges of the Arts; Liberal Arts; Business Administration; Education; Engineering; General Studies; Nursing; Science; and the Graduate School. The University has an approximate enrollment of 16,300 students with a faculty of 550 and offers degree programs in 80 disciplines, the master's degree in 29 disciplines, and the doctorate in 9 disciplines.
