Assistant or Associate Professor of Communication, to work within the Interpersonal/Organizational Sequence

The Department of Communication at the University of Louisiana at Lafayette (<http://comm.louisiana.edu> and <http://www.louisiana.edu>) seeks an Assistant or Associate Professor of Communication to work within the Interpersonal and Organizational Communication sequence. This scholar will teach at both the graduate and undergraduate levels beginning August of 2008. A Ph.D. in Communication is required for either appointment, however a significant body of scholarship must be evidenced for appointment at the Associate rank. This is a 10-month, full-time, tenure-track position.

Candidates applying for this position will be expected to teach topics such as (but not exclusively limited to): research methods, organizational communication, interpersonal communication, interviewing, communication theory, group problem-solving, and communication consultation. Ideally, this candidate will have developed a research program in some aspect of interpersonal or organizational communication and can contribute to the long-term growth of the program. In addition to quality teaching and research, graduate faculty members are expected to provide support to both our BA and MS programs by serving on masters thesis committees, evaluating masters comprehensive exams, participating in curriculum development, advising students, and supporting other disciplines in the department as necessary.
