POSITION: Instructor (Academic Year) of Sociology

RESPONSIBILITIES: The candidate will teach undergraduate courses, specifically, General Sociology, Marriage & Family, Social Interaction and Criminology; recruit and advise students; participate in professional organizations; perform research and disseminate information through publication and presentation; and serve on departmental and university committees.

QUALIFICATIONS: Candidate must have earned a Master's Degree in sociology or related field; Ph.D. preferred. Candidate must demonstrate evidence of leadership, research ability, teaching in higher education setting, good interpersonal skills, and involvement in professional activities.

ADMINISTRATIVE: The University of Louisiana at Lafayette is one of 8 publicly supported universities in the University of Louisiana system. It consists of 9 degree-granting units - The Colleges of the Arts; Liberal Arts; Business Administration; Education; Engineering; General Studies; Nursing; Science; and the Graduate School. The University has an approximate enrollment of 16,300 students with a faculty of 550 and offers degree programs in 80 disciplines, the master's degree in 29 disciplines, and the doctorate in 9 disciplines.
