- POSITION:** Instructor (Academic Year) of Sociology
- RESPONSIBILITIES:** The candidate will teach undergraduate courses, specifically, General Sociology and Social Problems; recruit and advise students; participate in professional organizations and serve on departmental committees.
- QUALIFICATIONS:** Candidate must have earned a Master's Degree in Sociology or closely related field. Candidate must demonstrate evidence of leadership, research ability, teaching in higher education setting, good interpersonal skills, and involvement in professional activities.
