Position: GIS Analyst

Duties: Under the direction of the MIS Director, this position will utilize Geographic Information Systems techniques to provide a better understanding of certain variables in a given geographic location. The position will extract data from GIS software and use varying analysis methods to arrive at results, recommend appropriate reactionary strategies in response to GIS analysis, and provide maps and data sets to clients to supplement analysis. The position will work both independently and as part of a multi-disciplinary team focused on producing high quality outputs in a collaborative manner.

Qualifications: Bachelor's degree (Master's degree preferred) in computer science or related field and 2-3 years of experience in the field or in a related area. The candidate must be knowledgeable of GIS software and technology. Also, must be knowledgeable of various publicly available resources of data related to underlying state and parish level demographics, economic indicators, and related information. The ideal candidate would be familiar with the fields of education, public health, program evaluation, and research.

Funding: Initial funding will come from Longitudinal Study (State appropriations) and Coordinated School Health (State appropriations) and continued funding will come from state appropriations and future contracts.
