Position: Statistician

Duties: Under the direction of the MIS Director, the position will analyze and interpret data from various sources. Duties include organizes, stores, and collects data to ensure high quality, repeatable analyses. Compiles reports, charts, and tables based on established statistical methods. Provides support for basic statistical analyses of large data sets, development and execution of statistical analysis plans, the selection of statistical methods, statistical software, and the interpretation and dissemination of research findings.

Qualifications: Bachelor's Degree required (Master's preferred) in statistics, information technology or in a related area. The ideal candidate will have experience using analytical software (such as Excel or SPSS) and related tools for education and health related research projects. The candidate must have experienced in summarizing scientific research involving statistical analysis in written form and verbal presentations. Knowledgeable and experience at selecting and applying appropriate statistical and data analysis techniques to longitudinal educational, health and epidemiologic data. Experience with logistic regression, decision trees, survival analysis, hierarchical linear modeling, text analysis, design of experiment and other statistical techniques is desired.

Funding: Initial funding will come from Longitudinal Study (State appropriations) and continued funding will come from state appropriations and future contracts.
