**Position Title:** Clinical Veterinarian

## **Location**

## **Organization**

The position reports to the Head of the Division of Veterinary Sciences. NIRC is composed of four divisions: Animal Resources, Research Resources, Behavioral Sciences, and Veterinary Sciences. An AAALAC international accredited facility, NIRC houses approximately 6000 nonhuman primates (including Great Apes, Old World and New World species). Our mission is to provide resources and support for the conduct of basic and applied research aimed at the solution of human health and societal problems.

## **Major Responsibilities**

Responsibilities include providing therapeutic, surgical, and diagnostic support for several breeder programs; evaluating animals and monitoring animal health on various research protocols, such as safety, pharmacokinetic, and efficacy, for the biotechnological and pharmaceutical industry; providing support and instruction to students, residents, visiting veterinarians, and clinical veterinary technicians in the principles and application of non-human primate medicine.

## **Qualifications**

DVM/VMD from an AVMA- accredited school of veterinary medicine. Experience with non-human primates is preferred but not required. New graduates will be considered. Interpersonal/communication skills are essential. A highly motivated, self-starter type of individual is sought.
