Organization

The position reports to the Head of the Division of Veterinary Sciences. NIRC is composed of four divisions: Animal Resources, Research Resources, Behavioral Sciences, and Veterinary Sciences. An AAALAC international accredited facility, NIRC houses approximately 6000 nonhuman primates (including Great Apes, Old World and New World species). Our mission is to provide resources and support for the conduct of basic and applied research aimed at the solution of human health and societal problems.

Major Responsibilities

Provide preventive, diagnostic, therapeutic, and surgical support for several nonhuman primate programs; provide supervisory oversight in the application of efficacy, safety, and pharmacokinetic research protocols utilizing nonhuman primates, which will involve logistical planning, scheduling, initiation, and implementation of protocols developed for pharmaceutical and biotechnological industry; development, implementation (via employee training), and upgrading of standard Operating Procedures for a specialized area of support including safety, preventive maintenance, and general use/operation.

Qualifications

Bachelor of Science degree or equivalent degree with scientific emphasis. Individual must demonstrate the ability to communicate effectively with all staff members and visitors to the NIRC.
